

DESCRIPTION

The effect of agriculture on groundwater resources has been a lingering but ever growing concern in agricultural regions across the nation for decades. Fertilizers and pesticides are showing up at increasing rates in water supply wells, increases in irrigation pumping have affected baseflow to streams, and the growth of drain tile use results in water leaving the landscape faster than ever.

In Minnesota, regulatory changes have brought the effect of agriculture on groundwater to the headlines once again. Some examples include: the 2015 buffer law, proposed rules regarding nitrate in groundwater, and potential implementation of stricter controls of agricultural irrigation in some parts of the state.

The immense scale of these issues, in time, geography, and economics, make them difficult to study and even harder to manage or fix. The MGWA Fall Conference will present a sampling of some of the latest research related to agriculture's impact on groundwater resources. We will shed some light on the problems we face today in Minnesota and across the country, what's being done to address these issues, and what might be needed in the future.
